



RoHS 2002/95/EC Compliance

Directive 2002/95/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 January 2003 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment

On January 27, 2003, the European Union has issued a directive to regulate the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electric and electronic equipment. This directive numbered 2002/95/EC (RoHS) prohibits the use of lead (Pb), mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd), hexavalent chromium (Cr6), polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) in all electric and electronic parts circulating within the EU after July 1, 2006.
